## TOYS

It is extremely important for dogs (especially service dogs) to have plenty of toys to keep them busy. Dogs that have a job often get bored if they do not have something to do. That boredom can often result in them chewing on and destroying your things. This also can cause life threatening situations if objects are swallowed. We recommend that your doggie have 15-20 toys. Give them access to half of them at a time. If you notice them getting bored with those toys (approximately every 2 months), switch the toys out with the other half, and so on.

We advise against giving your dog rawhide treats.

### HARD TOYS
